- 'Remedy' – Music from the Anne Frank Commission
- Education pack put together by Northwood, Kingston, Muswell Hill and Finchley
- 'Into the Arms of Strangers' – A teacher's pack, including a film. Suitable for KS2.
- 'Reflections' – HET – available to every secondary school in the country.
- Use a picture of the sculpture in Liverpool St. Station of Jewish refugees as a stimulus.
- 3 Faiths Forum
- 'Imagine' – a piece of prose about leaving/separation from the perspective of a child, parent or foster carer.
- Finchley Catholic School created a drama and music performance which they performed at old peoples' homes and Limmud.
